Required Documentation:

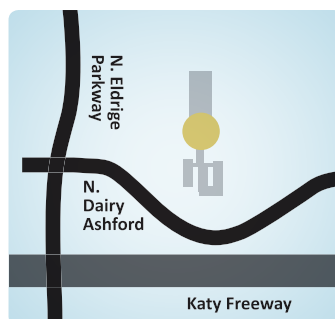
To get started, the following government-issued documents are required to open an account or obtain a loan:

- ✓ Passport from Country of Origin
- ✓ Visa
- ✓ I-94
- ✓ Customs and Border Protection Arrival/Departure Information
(This may also be stamped on your Passport)
- ✓ Social Security Card
- ✓ ITIN Card
- ✓ Must have an Employee Verification Letter and the Employee Verification Letter must be on company letterhead and include:
 - Employee's start date
 - Position
 - Salary
 - Tax status
 - Confirmation that U.S. government-issued documents have been requested
 - Company HR representative to contact regarding additional information
- ✓ Housing Confirmation: Leasing Agreement, Drivers License, Deed of Trust or Utility Bill
(employer sponsored if Expat doesn't have his/her own housing)
- ✓ W-8BEN
